Submission of full paper does not ensure the acceptance of paper for the conference; depending upon conformity with theme/subthemes etc. the selection of papers would be finalized. Full papers must be submitted through e-mail at nsdpbsc@gmail.com or on Google form link along with registration proof latest by 5th April 2026.
