

Dr. Shailendra Kumar Singh is currently serving as the Head, Department of Teacher Education at DPBS College, Anupshahr. He has been an integral part of the college since 21st February 2007. Academically accomplished, he holds M.A. (Sociology), M.Sc. (Botany), and Ph.D. (Botany), along with M.Ed., M.Phil. (Education), and UGC-NET in Education.
