IIT GATE: - Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) is a national examination conducted jointly by the Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bangalore and the Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) on behalf of the National Coordination Board (NCB)-GATE, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India.

Qualifying in GATE is a mandatory requirement for seeking admission and/or financial assistance to (i) Master's programs and direct Doctoral programs in Engineering/Technology/Architecture and (ii) Doctoral programs in relevant branches of Arts and Science, in the institutions supported by the MoE and other Government agencies.

IIT JAM: - IITs started conducting a Joint Admission Test for M.Sc. (JAM). The objective of JAM is to provide admissions to M.Sc. (Two-Year), Joint M.Sc.-Ph.D., M.Sc.-Ph.D. Dual Degree, and other Post-Bachelor's Degree Programmes at IITs and Integrated Ph.D. Degree Programmes at IISc Bangalore and to consolidate Science as a career option for bright students across the country.

GATE EXAMINATION

Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) is a national level examination that primarily tests the comprehensive understanding of various undergraduate subjects in Engineering/Technology/Architecture/Science/Commerce/Arts. GATE 2023 will be a computer-based test (CBT), which is being organized by Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur. The examination will be conducted by IISc Bangalore and seven IITs (IIT Bombay, IIT Delhi, IIT Guwahati, IIT Kanpur, IIT Kharagpur, IIT Madras, IIT Roorkee), on behalf of the National Coordination Board – GATE, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India (GoI). GATE 2023 Examination will be conducted at specific centres in selected cities and towns in India, and a few cities outside India. GATE 2023 score will remain valid for THREE YEARS from the date of announcement of results.

Candidates may appear either in ONE or TWO papers. For candidates who choose TWO papers, the combination must be from the approved list and subject to the availability of infrastructure and date.

ELIGIBILITY & OPPORTUNITIES

A candidate who is currently studying in 3rd or higher years of any undergraduate degree program OR has already completed any government approved degree program in Engineering/Technology/Architecture/Science/Commerce/Arts, is eligible to take this examination. Qualified GATE score can be used for seeking admission and/or financial assistance to: (i) Master's programs and direct Doctoral programs in Engineering/Technology/Architecture/Science/Commerce/Arts; and (ii) Doctoral programs in relevant branches of Arts and Science, in the institutions supported by the MoE and other Government agencies, subject to fulfilling the admission criteria of the admitting institutes. The GATE score is also used by some colleges and institutions for admitting students without MoE scholarship/assistantship. Further, many Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) have been using GATE score in their recruitment process.

JAM 2023 Examination

- + JAM 2023 is a Computer Based Test to be conducted in SEVEN Test Papers at the undergraduate level.
- + Test Papers will have three objective type of questions: (i) Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ), (ii) Multiple Select Questions (MSQ), and (iii) Numerical Answer Type (NAT).
- + Candidates may appear in ONE or TWO Test Papers.
- + Candidates who wish to appear in two Test Papers must ensure that both are not scheduled in the same session.
- + Eligible for direct admission to around 3000 seats in various postgraduate programmes at IITs.
- + Candidates who have completed an undergraduate degree or currently studying in the final year of undergraduate programme are eligible to apply for JAM 2023 examination.
- + Foreign Nationals with Indian degree are eligible to apply, subject to the policy of the Admitting Institute.

Admission Procedure

- + Candidates who qualify in any Test Paper of JAM 2023 will be eligible to apply for admission to specific academic programmes subject to the satisfaction of the Eligibility Requirements and Minimum Educational Qualifications (MEQs).
- + Admission shall be given as per merit, reservation policy of Government of India, and the availability of seats.
- + Proof of having passed the qualifying degree should be submitted by September 29, 2023.
- + Candidates promoted without a marksheet should produce a certificate stating the subjects studied in that semester/year duly signed by the Head of the Institute.
- + Additional details on MEQs are available on JAM 2023 website.
- + Qualifying in JAM 2023 does not guarantee admission to postgraduate programmes or any scholarship/financial assistance.
