It is a matter of great pleasure that Durga Prasad Baljit Singh Post Graduate College, Anupshahar has completed 53 years of its establishment. In this period from 1965 to 2018, the college has progressively made structural and qualitative progress. Many students of the college have brought laurels to the college in academic and various co-curricular programs

at the university level. At present, four aided and four self-financed courses are being run, in which a total of 1527 students are studying. In terms of academic achievements and discipline, this college holds its own special place in Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut.
